Subject: Devon Local Flood Risk Management Strategy public consultation 27th November - 27th January

Dear Parish Clerk,

Devon County Council, together with partner authorities and key stakeholders in Devon, have produced the draft Local Flood Risk Management Strategy which is available to view online from Wednesday 27th November. This marks the start of the public consultation which continues until Monday 27th January 2014.

The high level strategic document outlines the responsibilities of the Risk Management Authorities in Devon and how they are working in partnership to coordinate local flood risk management. This covers everything from engaging with communities and preparing for floods, responding to flood events, collaborating on flood risk studies and investing in flood improvements.

Devon County Council is the Lead Local Flood Authority for its area and has produced this strategy in line with the Flood and Water Management Act 2010. It consists of a collection of documents including a summary report, full technical report and local action plan. The action plan prioritises areas and communities that require flood alleviation works.

A hard copy of the main Technical Report and the Summary Report will also be available at District Council Offices and in the main reception of County Hall in Exeter.
