WHAT CAN I RECYCLE AND WHERE DO I PUT IT?

Your recycling needs to be separated into your containers this way:



Your green recycling box

✓ Cardboard

- Egg boxes
- Tubes from toilet/kitchen rolls
- Folded brown cardboard boxes
- Card from packaging like toys
- Food packaging (like cereal boxes, cardboard sleeves)

✗ **No takeout pizza boxes, plastic film or polystyrene**

✓ Small electrical items Bagged

- Irons
- Kettles
- Toasters


✓ Paper

✓ Shredded paper

 Bagged to prevent litter

✓ Glass bottles/jars

✓ Textiles/shoes

 Bagged to keep together and dry

✓ Batteries Bagged to keep them together



Your green reusable sack

 Wash off food residue + squash

✓ Plastics

- Yoghurt pots
 - Plastic meat and vegetable trays
 - Margarine and ice cream tubs
 - Plastic bottles
- ✗ **No plastic film or wrappers, polystyrene, pill casings and rigid plastics (like toys and plant pots)**

✓ Cartons/Tetra Paks

✓ Tins and cans ✓ Aerosols

✓ Foil (including trays)



Use newspaper or compostible bags in your food caddies

Your blue food caddy

✓ Food waste

- Fruit and vegetable peelings
- Cooked food
- Uncooked food
- Meat/fish (including bones)
- Plate scrapings
- Cat/dog food
- Tea bags/coffee grounds

Remember, your recycling
and food waste is collected
from the kerbside every week

HOW DO THINGS NEED TO LOOK ON RECYCLING DAY?



Please stack your
recycling this way:

- 1 Your new green reusable sack
- 2 Your green recycling box
- 3 Flattened large cardboard

CAN I PUT OUT EXTRA RECYCLING?

Yes. This can be put in
a durable bag or box
and placed to the side
of your recycling box.
