Curriculum Provision

Key Stage 1 (Robins and Little Acorns)

This week in our English lessons we have had a non-fiction focus. Reception children wrote Mrs Chown a shopping list for Children in need spotty biscuits and KS1 children wrote instructions for making them. In Maths we have been adding 10 to 2-digit numbers. Our Shape, Space and Measure focus was using rulers to measure. It was great timing when the school nurse came to do Year R and Year 6 height and weight checks. The children enjoyed using the nurse's measuring equipment to measure each other and record their height. In Science we have been planting bulbs and talking about how they grow.

Key Stage 2 (Owls)

Owls' have had a fantastic week! We have competed in a Tag Rugby competition against other children from across the Acorn Academy. We did really well and came third! On Tuesday afternoon we enjoyed our forest school session, making hedgehog houses and little clay creatures. In English this week we have been delving deeper into the Hidden Forest, researching ways to save the underwater kelp forest. Maths has seen us further reinforcing and learning our times tables in preparation for applying these to multiplication and division calculations next week. In Topic we have been learning about the origins of place names across the United Kingdom and how we can identify when they were founded.





