As everyone knows, as of tomorrow, Thursday 5th November, England will go into a month long period of lockdown which will last until Wednesday 2 December. One of the immediate consequences of lockdown will be the cancellation of all services of worship in our churches throughout November.

REMEMBRANCE DAY SERVICES

Remembrance Day services are an important part of our civic and community response to the tragedy of war. They are an opportunity to remember and show gratitude to those who have committed to protect the people and values of this country, even at the greatest cost to themselves.

All services planned to take place in churches on Sunday 8 November, have been cancelled due to Covid-19 restrictions.

Outdoor Services of Remembrance can take place. Please refer to individual churches and community websites to check whether these are taking place in your local community.

A number of communities have rearranged outdoor and war memorial services. These will be carried out with appropriate social distancing, face coverings and hygiene arrangements in place. They must include “track and trace” recording of those attending and their contact details. This information will be held for 21 days and then destroyed. It will be up to the organisers of events to ensure that the necessary arrangements are in place. Where the services take place on church property, the PCC must ensure compliance.

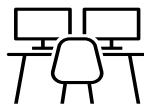
